
Please ensure that all consent forms are returned to the school as soon as possible and that your contact details are kept up to date. This is very important in case we have to contact you in an emergency.

We will learn our September rhymes and songs. Please help at home.


We will learn our snack routine and of course we will always say "please" and "thank you"
